Traditionally, promoting alcohol education, awareness, and moderation among college students has been a very challenging endeavor. Abusive and under-aged alcohol consumption continues to be the number one health concern for many universities. Counselors, health educators, Residence Life, Greek organizations and Dean of Students representatives have longed for a harm-reduction alcohol presentation that might gain the attention of and motivate the students they serve. After a long day of being lectured at, students just don't desire another one. This is especially true if those lectures challenge behaviors they believe are just part of the norm and contribute to their desire to fit in and feel independent.
